## THE PRESIDENT'S CORNER

I know we were all saddened over the passing of Carol Gatto at 14100 Shawhan Place, and that you join me in prayers and thoughts for her and her family.

On July 28 a meeting of the Board was held. We discussed the painting of the first 18 houses and the quality of the test house at Roy and Anita Dahlquist's which looks good. We ratified the paint contract and siding replacement on some homes damaged by the sun's heat reflecting off of some home's upper windows with Metro Group. These contracts we had approved earlier in order to ensure painting this summer. Community Partners will advise you when this painting will start. The Board approved the adoption of a rule that window screens must be kept on upper windows to help ensure that no more siding in the future needs to be replaced. Also please pay attention to your hot grills because if they are too close to the house, warpage of the siding can occur. Worst yet, this could start a fire. The Board also approved a requirement that all homeowners provide Community Partners with a certificate of insurance as is authorized in our Declaration. This is to insure that all homeowners are protected from a catastrophe. Community Partners will be sending you a letter outlining these requirements.

The Reserve Study is complete and reviewed. It will be used to determine how much money we need to place in the reserve fund for replacement of siding, roofing etc. in the future. This study will be used in the budget development later this year.

Don't forget the National Night Out on August 4.

I hope you are enjoying the summer and I look forward to seeing you around the neighborhood.

## **POWER WASH SCHEDULE**

Here are some things homeowners should do before houses are powerwashed in August:

- > Check all windows to ensure they are closed tight and locked so that water does not get inside your home when it is power washed.
- ➤ Remove all screens from the first floor windows. DO NOT REMOVE screens in the second floor windows located on the side(s) of your house due to the sun's reflection off the windows and onto your neighbor's vinyl siding. Screens removed from second floor windows for short periods of time have caused siding to melt and buckle. This has happened to several homes already and the repairs are very costly to the HOA.
